

## CROSS-LINGUAL LINKING

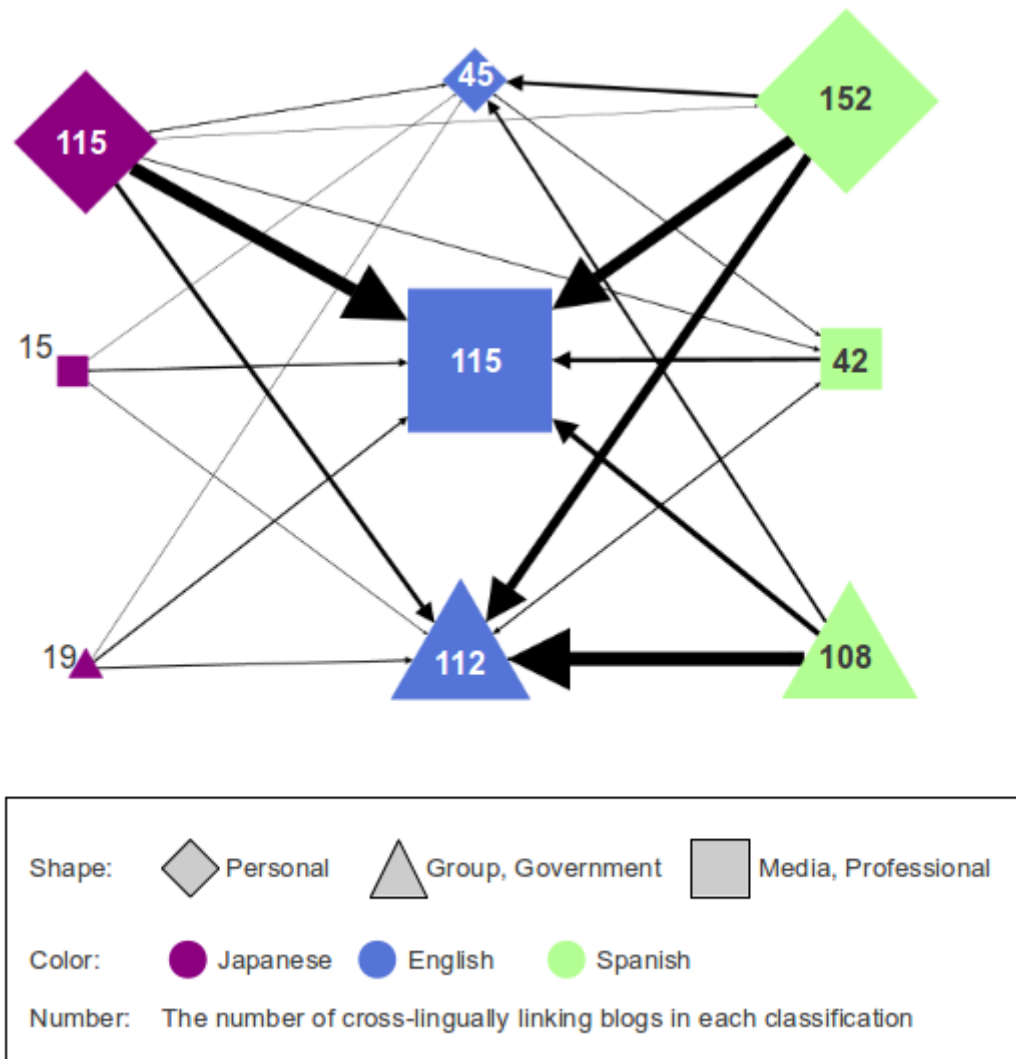


Figure 3: Cross-lingual hyperlink network diagram. This network diagram shows all cross-lingual links by creator/destination type and language. Shape identifies the type of entity (personal, group, or media/professional) creating or receiving the link, and the arrow width is proportional to the number of links sent/received. Node size is proportional to the number of cross-lingually linking blogs in each classification, and this number is written on each node. The nodes are hand positioned as same-language links—which have been omitted—hold nodes of the same language tightly together. English receives the majority of cross-lingual links, while few links directly connect Japanese and Spanish.
